Dear Festival Nonprofit Organization Participant:

On behalf of the Festival Committee, I would like to take this opportunity to thank you for your continued interest in the "Fayetteville...Host of Christmas Past." ***This year festivities will begin on Friday afternoon with the first of three cooking shows with Michael Wright at 4:00 p.m. and continue until 9:00 p.m., with activities around the square and on the bandstand. No nonprofit activities will take place on the courthouse lawn on Friday evening. Of course, there will be a full slate of activities throughout the day on Saturday. Host-sponsored activities will begin again at 1:00 p.m. on Sunday afternoon and conclude at 5:00 p.m.***

***The booth fee is \$45 (\$35 application fee and \$10 sign deposit). If you need electricity, there will be an additional \$15 charge (for a total booth fee of \$60).*** After closing on Sunday, return your sign to the Information Booth. Your \$10 deposit will be returned to you by mail.

We will require that ***all*** organizations wishing to participate complete the application form, which is enclosed. The application ***must*** be returned to the Chamber of Commerce located at 208 South Elk Avenue or to P.O. Box 515, Fayetteville, TN 37334 by ***4:00 p.m. on Monday, September 24<sup>th</sup>.*** ***Fees for applications submitted after this date will be doubled.*** If you know of another interested organization, please make them aware of this deadline and the application process. Applications will soon be available at [www.hostofchristmaspast.com](http://www.hostofchristmaspast.com).

We plan to have tents for nonprofit booths again this year. Nonprofit booths will be distributed over the entire courthouse lawn. Booth locations will be assigned, on a first come first serve basis, by the festival oversight committee. This year's brochure will be in an ad/coupon booklet format. Sponsors will be listed in the form of an ad with the size dependent up the level of sponsorship. The nonprofit names and items sold will not be listed in the brochure. Your organization may be recognized in the brochure by being a sponsor and purchasing an ad.
